IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

Licensing requirements make it necessary to inform you that certain waste cannot be put in the garbage:

<u>YARD WASTE</u> – Leaves, brush, trees, grass clippings, garden debris, pumpkins, dirt, etc;

<u>DEMOLITION WASTE</u> – Sheetrock, large boards, railroad ties, shingles, rock & concrete and other similar materials or tires and batteries; large metal items, steel, pvc plastics (in large quantities), large machinery parts or large metal items.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE – Pesticides, poisons, paint, thinners, gas, motor oil and other similar items; fluorescent bulbs, electronic capacitors and ballasts; nickel cadmium, lithium batteries;

ELECTRONICS, APPLIANCES, AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS
Computers, monitors, computer processors, microuveyes, televisions

Computers, monitors, computer processors, microwaves, televisions, stoves, refrigerators, dishwashers and any other appliance; furniture, mattress.

The items noted above can be brought to the Becker County Transfer Station or you can make arrangements with us-to haul them for you, but additional charges will apply.

Also as a requirement of our license we must inform you of the following information:

- 1. We dispose of all collected garbage at the Becker County Transfer Station located at 24413 County Rd 144, Detroit Lakes; from there Becker County hauls the garbage to the Fargo Landfill for final disposal.
- 2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statute 115A.9302 (b) we are required to inform you that "you may be responsible for any liability that results from contamination at a facility where your waste has been deposited."
